Impact of the Practice: One special mention to be made is a workshop on "Understanding Gender-Sexuality" conducted in collaboration with Sappho for Equality, a renowned Non-Governmental Organisation that works to raise awareness on issues of gender and sexuality. This workshop was a resounding success as all students heartily participated in the workshop and learnt crucial concepts.

Resources required: More funds and more collaborations with local ngos and governmental organisations are needed to make gender equality a reality in this day and age and in Purulia.
